Covered 100% by the County:

Chemistry Panel - Includes heart, kidney and liver functions, with lipid panel, total cholesterol, HDL(good), LDL (bad) and triglycerides. Also includes glucose, iron and TSH (thyroid stimulating hormone), uric acid and carbon dioxide.

Recommended 12hour fasting, unless diabetic.

CBC - Complete blood count for red and white blood cells, platelet levels, hemoglobin and hematocrit. Checks for anemia, infections and other blood disorders.

A1c - Gives the average blood sugar levels over the past two to three months. Recommended for diabetics or those with a family history of high blood sugar.

PSA - One tool used to screen for prostate abnormalities. Recommended for men over 40 or those with a family history of prostate cancer.

Vitamin D, 25 hydroxy - Screening for overall Vitamin D status, deficiency or toxicity. Vitamin D is important for mineral absorption, the immune system, strong bones and overall health.

Thyroid panel 1 - Includes T3 uptake, total T4 and calculates a freeThyroxine index.

C-Reactive Protein - An elevated CRP is a marker of inflammation and can help to evaluate risk of cardiovascular disease, inflammatory disorders or infections.

Patient pays for extras:

Thyroid Panel 2 - This test delivers a more enhanced thyroid profile.

T3, Reverse - Measures the inactive form of the hormone. It is not regularly checked as often as other thyroid hormones but may be tested when someone is experiencing symptoms of low thyroid production but shows normal results from other thyroid tests.

Thyroid Antibodies - Checks for antibodies that can injure the thyroid, affecting thyroid function.

Sar-Covid Antibody - Checks if you have been exposed to COVID-19.

Blood type - ABO RH - Determination of blood type.

Ferritin - Indicates levels of iron protein stored in the body.

Rheumatoid Arthritis panel - These tests can help identify rheumatoid arthritis (RA) and arthritis associated with autoimmune disorders.

Testosterone Total - Men or women: screens for levels of testosterone hormones.

Vitamin B12 with Folate - Detects nutrient levels necessary for normal red blood cell and white blood cell formation and repair of tissues and cells. These cannot be produced in the body and must be supplied by the diet. ***Biotin consumption should be discontinued for at least 72 hours prior to testing.**

Celiac Screening - Used to aid in the diagnosis of gluten sensitivity. *You must be on a gluten containing diet for testing.

Hepatitis C Antibody - Checks for antibodies to Hep. C indicating a previous infection.
